

Board of Supervisors Township Minutes
November 10, 2016

Chairman Gregory called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and the Lord's Prayer.

Supervisors present were Joseph Gregory, Reginald Daubert and Dean Patches. Also present was Jennifer Harding, Mickey Gartlan, Attorney Andrew Race; Engineer, Jeff Golding; and 6 residents.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Supervisor Gregory stated that a lot of people came through the township building to vote. He thanked the many people it took to set up for the election. The road crew that assisted during the election polling, polling workers and the Bunker Hill Fire Department.

Linda L'Orange, a Lighthouse Drive resident expressed concern over the number of vehicles parking on both sides of the road making it very difficult to see children. Dean Patches noted that this is a public roadway. Unless a vehicle is unlicensed, cars are allowed to park along the roadway.
