OLD BUSINESS

Inwood Bridge Project

The Township will contact John Bachman, PennDot Engineer, to set up a meeting to review the bridge project and discuss the road widening, stormwater pipes and construction traffic. Engineer Jeff Golding recommended to video tape the road and shoulder to document the existing road conditions.

Ordinance Review

A draft Abandon Vehicle Ordinance was distributed. Verbiage will be added that would allow an abandon vehicle that is a safety hazard to be moved within 48-72 hours. The Abandon Vehicle Ordinance will be added to the November Planning Commission agenda for discussion.

Mill Street Heights Basin

The property owner has not responded. Supervisor Patches will again try to make contact with the Carpenters to schedule a meeting.

2017 Trunk or Treat

The lack of trunks was discussed. The Rec Board will be contacted to determine number of trunks. The event will be Saturday, October 28, 2017 from 1:00-3:00 p.m. at the park.

NEW BUSINESS

Misty Glen Land Development - Request for Extension

Supervisor Patches moved to grant the 90-day extension. Seconded by Gregory. All voted in favor; motion carried.

Auditor Agreement

Attorney Gallo has reviewed the agreement with Garcia Garman and Shea. She stated that what is in place is an engagement letter, not a contract. Attorney Gallo will be contacting Garcia Garman and Shea to discuss the terms of the agreement.

Swatara Township Park Access

Swatara Township owns property along Old Route 22 which was purchased for Recreation. Discussion was held regarding the land and the need for future discussion.

Park Flag Pole Light

The flag pole light at the park needs to be replaced. Two lights were presented.

Supervisor Patches moved to purchase the \$200 commercial light. Seconded by Supervisor Daubert. All voted in favor; motion carried.

Union Township Intermunicipal Agreement

Supervisor Patches moved to authorize Attorney Gallo to advertise an ordinance to enter into an Intermunicipal Agreement with Union Township. Seconded by Supervisor Gregory. All voted in favor; motion carried.

Notice of Resignation

Supervisor Gregory read the letter of resignation from Road Foreman, Bryan Ziegler.

Supervisor Gregory moved to accept the resignation with regrets. Seconded by Supervisor Patches. All voted in favor; motion carried.

Supervisor Patches moved to ratify the advertising of the Road Foreman position. Seconded by Supervisor Gregory. All voted in favor; motion carried.

With no further comment or discussion, the workshop adjourned at 9:45a.m.
