OLD BUSINESS

Subdivision Basin Reviews

Mr. Deswert – 201 Lighthouse Drive – owns the property with the basin closest to SR22 which drains out to the creek in the woods. The plans show this basin to be 4-5' deep at the shallowest point and having an outlet with a plate with a 2" opening. After inspection by the Township's Engineer, the basin was constructed in accordance with the plan. There are a few items which require maintenance: there is brush at the inlet and high weeds at the outlet which need to be removed.

1700 Hain Avenue Subdivision Plan

After review of the latest submittal, Jeff Golding stated that the plan is ready for approval.

Supervisor Patches moved to approve the plan. Seconded by Supervisor Daubert. All voted in favor; motion carried.

The Supervisors adjourned into executive session at 9:00 a.m. to discuss a matter of potential litigation. The meeting reconvened at 9:05 a.m. No action is required.

Hain Avenue Pull-Offs

Discussion was held regarding the need to take the embankment back 10-12' temporarily. Once the road is widened, the pull-offs will no longer be needed. Yield to Oncoming Traffic signs may also be needed.

Stoner Road Bridge Repair

The waterproofing membrane is to be installed on November 1st and 2nd. The road will then be ready for paving.

NEW BUSINESS

Lancaster Street Bridge Repair

CMS anticipates being out in mid-November with divers that will be installing the grout bags.
