

**Swatara Township
Ordinance Workshop
August 25, 2021**

Those in attendance were Supervisor Bering and Supervisor Kreitzer. Absent was Supervisor Patches. Also in attendance was Nate Stephens, Light-Heigel; Engineer, Brent Ramsey from Gannett Fleming; Attorney, Colleen Gallo; and Township Staff Kirk Artz and Trish Harris.

Supervisor Kreitzer called the meeting to order 8:35 a.m.

Bunker Hill Fire Company Litigation

Supervisor Kreitzer, as Chief of the Bunker Hill Fire Company abstained from discussion. Due to the absence of Supervisor Patches, Supervisor Kreitzer was advised that he could participate in action.

Supervisor Kreitzer moved to continue the litigation against Yingst Engineers. Seconded by Supervisor Bering. All voted in favor; motion carried.

Stormwater Management – Brent Ramsey

Gannett Fleming Stormwater

Supervisor Bering moved to authorize Gannett Fleming to amend the stormwater ordinance for \$2,400.00. Seconded by Kreitzer. All voted in favor; motion carried.

Mill Street Swale Project

The proposed roads for paving in 2022 will be Darkes Road, Swatara Circle, Middle Avenue, Chestnut Street, Lighthouse Drive, Hilltop Road, Donna Drive and Darlington Avenue. Mr. Artz will be obtaining estimates for budget purposes.

Supervisor Kreitzer announced that the Bunker Hill Fire Company will hold an Open House for Fire Prevention week on October 2nd. Representative Diamond will hold a informational meeting on October 20th at the Bunker Hill Fire Company on concealed carry procedures.

Continuing Education

Supervisor Bering moved to authorize the registration of Trish Harris to attend a QuickBooks class at the PSATS center in Enola on October 12, 2021. Seconded by Supervisor Kreitzer. All voted in favor; motion carried.

Ordinance Discussions – Nate Stephens
