Linford Snyder Poultry Land Development Plan – Todd Geltmacher, Red Barn Consulting

1830 Kenbrook Road – Act 14 Letter

A letter requesting the Township respond to an Act 14 letter for the construction of two poultry houses at 1830 Kenbrook Road which then qualifies this operation as a Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO).

Supervisor Patches moved to authorize the completion of the Act 14 letter for 1830 Kenbrook Road. Seconded by Supervisor Bering. All voted in favor; motion carried.
